

PROMOTION REQUIREMENTS 2014

GRADES 8 AND 9

The final progression mark at the end of the year will be made up as follows:

40%	School-Based Assessment (SBA)
60%	End of Year Examination

Learners must obtain the following **minimum standards** in order to be promoted to the next grade:

Home Language (HL) i.e. English	Level 4: 50 – 59% (Adequate Achievement)
First Additional Language (FAL) i.e. Afrikaans / isiXhosa	Level 3: 40 – 49% (Moderate Achievement)
Mathematics	
Any THREE other subjects	
Any TWO of the remaining subjects	Level 2: 30 – 39% (Elementary Achievement)

GRADES 10 TO 12

The final progression mark at the end of the year will be made up as follows:

25 %	School-Based Assessment (SBA)
75 %	End of Year Examination

***PLEASE NOTE:** In **Grade 12**, the final mark for **Life Orientation** will be based on the internal assessment and an externally set Common Assessment Task.*

The **minimum** requirements for promotion in Grades 10 to 12 are indicated below:

Home Language (HL) i.e. English	40%
Any TWO other subjects	40%
Any THREE of the remaining subjects	30%
