

RUSTENBURG GIRLS' HIGH SCHOOL LANGUAGE POLICY

In terms of section 6(2) of *The South African Schools Act, No 84 of 1996*, as amended, the Governing Body of Rustenburg Girls' High School (RGHS) has approved of the following Language Policy in determining the language of instruction to learners at the school.

Language of Instruction.

The Governing Body of RGHS has determined that the school will be a single medium school and that the language of learning and teaching (excluding the subjects/learning areas of isiXhosa, Afrikaans, and any foreign languages offered by the school) will be English.

First Additional Languages

The school will promote multilingualism by offering the additional official languages of isiXhosa and Afrikaans as fully fledged subjects on a first additional language level.
