PURPOSE

Rustenburg Girls' High School believes that visible recognition should be given to learners for the purpose of motivating them. They will be rewarded for excellence, participation and commitment in activities offered at the school.

GENERAL

- 1. Only after lengthy and careful deliberation by the Colours Committee, are Colours awarded to learners. The decision of the Colours Committee is final and binding.
- 2. The Committee sits when necessary and the person in charge of the activity presents a fully completed form detailing the involvement of the learner concerned.

(Copies of application forms are available from the person in charge of the activity.)

THE COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO BESTOW AN AWARD

in exceptional circumstances, when not all of the fundamental criteria have been met.

- 3. Acceptable attendance means 80% attendance at practices and 100% attendance at matches/events/performances for which the candidate is chosen. It is the responsibility of the learner to ensure that her non-attendance is validated and that a doctor's certificate is provided where necessary.
- 4. National representation means a South African national team resulting from an unrestricted, inclusive selection process.
- 5. Learners, parents and staff must understand clearly that the awarding of Colours is not merely recognition of an activity well performed, but also recognition overall of excellent behaviour and appearance, loyalty and achievement.

THE COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REVOKE AN AWARD

if necessary, after due process has been followed.

6. CATEGORIES FOR THE AWARDING OF COLOURS:

FULL COLOURS

Embroidered scroll worn on blazer, below pocket – presented at Assembly Certificate – presented at the relevant Awards Ceremony

Requirements: Exceptional performance in terms of regional and national norms, as stipulated in this document.

The candidate must have

- a satisfactory record of behaviour and/or sportsmanship
- above average loyalty
- where relevant, an acceptable attendance record at practices and matches (valid, written excuses and injury will be taken into account)

HALF COLOURS

Embroidered straight bar worn on blazer, below pocket – presented at Assembly Certificate – presented at the relevant Awards Ceremony

Requirements: Outstanding performance in terms of regional and national norms, as stipulated in this document.

The candidate must have

- a satisfactory record of behaviour and/or sportsmanship
- above average loyalty
- where relevant, an acceptable attendance record at practices and matches (valid, written excuses and injury will be taken into account)

MERIT

Certificate – presented at Assembly / an Awards Assembly or other event

Requirements: A better than average performance, as stipulated in this document.

The candidate must have

- a satisfactory record of behaviour and/or sportsmanship
- above average loyalty
- where relevant, an acceptable attendance record at practices and matches (valid, written excuses and injury will be taken into account)

TEAM

Certificate - presented at Assembly / an Awards Assembly or other event

Requirements: representing the school for a period of time, as stipulated in this document.

The candidate must have

- a satisfactory record of behaviour and/or sportsmanship
- above average loyalty
- where relevant, an acceptable attendance record at practices and matches (valid, written excuses and injury will be taken into account)

MERITORIOUS MENTION

Certificate - presented at Assembly / an Awards Ceremony or other event

Requirements: National or provincial selection and representation in an activity outside of the school's extra-curricular programme.

Meritorious Mention may also be awarded for a learner's participation in other activities and achievements not specified in this policy, with the view to acknowledgement thereof, at the discretion of the Colours Committee.

SOUTH AFRICAN REPRESENTATIVE

Rustenburg South African Representative Badge – presented at Assembly / an Awards Ceremony or other event

Requirements: National selection and representation at an international level.

This badge may also be awarded for participation in activities or events not specified in this policy, with the view to acknowledgement thereof, at the discretion of the Colours Committee.

7. TERMINATION OR ADDITION OF ACTIVITIES

The Governing Body, in consultation with the staff, determines the school's extra-mural curriculum. The availability of coaching staff, or other reasons, may necessitate the termination or addition of extra-mural activities.

Where an activity is terminated, and will therefore not continue, the Colours Policy will be amended for future reference, to record the last year in which the relevant award will be made.

Where an activity is added, the Colours Committee, in consultation with the coaching staff or other relevant educator/s, will compile criteria for the awarding of Colours.

8. AWARDING OF COLOURS

All Colours awards will be announced and/or presented in the presence of the learner's peers. Half and Full Colour awards will also be acknowledged and certificates presented at the relevant annual awards ceremony.

All sport awards are to be made as soon after the completion of the season as possible.

THE INDIVIDUAL LEARNER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR APPLYING FOR THE APPROPRIATE AWARD

Educators and those in charge of activities should identify and encourage learners who meet the criteria to submit an application form. Any incorrect information on the motivation form may render the application invalid.

<u>Note</u>: This requirement does not apply to Academic Colours (where learners who qualify will be identified by the school) or to Society and Service certificates (where teachers will nominate learners).

SERVICES:

Certificate – presented at Gratitude Assembly

- The certificate can only be awarded to Grade 12 learners
- The learner must have been involved in the service for a minimum of 1 year, including the current year
- The teacher-in-charge is responsible for determining specific criteria and nominating worthy recipients

SOCIETIES:

Certificate – presented at Matric Awards Ceremony

- The certificate should preferably be awarded to a Grade 12 learner
- The learner must have been involved in the society committee for a minimum of 1 year, including the current year
- The teacher-in-charge is responsible for determining specific criteria and nominating a worthy recipient
- Only one certificate will be awarded (although a tie is allowed)

NOTE: Where the intended recipient is not a Grade 12 learner, the nomination must be submitted to the Colours Committee for consideration. If the award is approved, the certificate will be awarded to the learner during an assembly in Term 4.

<u>ACADEMIC</u>

Academic Awards will be awarded to learners in Grades 10, 11 and 12 only.

FULL COLOURS: an aggregate of 80% + in two consecutive examination terms

HALF COLOURS: an aggregate of 75% + in two consecutive examination terms

MERIT AWARD : Not awarded in this category

TEAM AWARD : Not awarded in this category

Examination results from June of the learner's Grade 10 year until the September of her Grade 12 year will be applicable.

Examination terms are as follows: Terms 2 + 4 for Grades 10 and 11

Terms 2 + 3 for Grade 12

AGGREGATE CALCULATIONS

<u>Grades 10 and 11</u>: A learner's aggregate will be calculated using the **four core subjects** of English (Home Language), Afrikaans or isiXhosa First Additional Language, Mathematics or Mathematical Literacy and Life Orientation, plus the **three highest electives**.

<u>Grade 12</u>: In keeping with the National and Provincial Education Departments' calculations to identify the top academic learners in the National Senior Certificate Examinations, the Grade 12 aggregate will be calculated using the **three core subjects** of English (Home Language), Afrikaans or isiXhosa First Additional Language, Mathematics or Mathematical Literacy, plus the **three highest electives** (i.e. Life Orientation is excluded from the aggregate calculation).

NOTE: With particular reference to subsequent awards, each examination aggregate will only be used once in the application of this policy. Exception may, however, be made if it means that a learner will then qualify for a higher award than has previously been achieved (i.e. Full Colours).

Learners who are absent for an examination (or part thereof), as well as those found cheating during an examination, will not be eligible for Academic Colours. In other words, that particular set of examination results will not be used in the application of this policy.

DRAMA

FULL COLOURS

Had leading roles (or equivalent credits) in three stage productions, including one during the current year, at least one of which should have been at/for RGHS

AND

At least three years of participation/involvement in stage productions at/for RGHS, including the current year

NOTE:

- "Leading role" can also be defined as being part of a tableau cast.
- Equivalent credits: Awarded Best Director, Best Scriptwriter, Best Production Designer or Best Actress in a Leading or Supporting Role at the Inter-House Drama Festival

HALF COLOURS

Had leading roles (or equivalent credits) in two stage productions, including one during the current year, at least one of which should have been at/for RGHS

AND

Participated/involved in stage productions at/for RGHS for at least three years, including the current year

NOTE:

- "Leading role" can also be defined as being part of a tableau cast.
- Equivalent credits: Awarded Best Director, Best Scriptwriter, Best Production Designer or Best Actress in a Leading or Supporting Role at the Inter-House Drama Festival

MERIT AWARD

Participated/involved in stage productions at/for RGHS for at least three years, including the current year

- This may include school dramatic productions, musical productions, the Inter-House Drama Festival, the South African Girls' Schools' Festival, the Bishops Play festival amongst others.
- This may also include contributions made as part of the backstage production team.

OR

Being part of a cast/stage production that has won a provincial or national competition (such as the National Girls' Schools' Festival)

TEAM AWARD: Not awarded in this category

MUSIC

FULL COLOURS

OPTION 1

Involved in at least three active school music groups for at least three years, including the current year

AND

Achieved a minimum of Grade 7 in her solo instrument in the ABRSM/Trinity Guildhall/UNISA/ALMSA/Rockschool examination, and gained at least 75%

AND

In the past 12 months, has played her solo instrument or in a small ensemble (comprising learners only) in one of the following, and achieved results in the top two categories of awards:

- Cape Town Eisteddfod
- Kaapse Afrikaanse Eisteddfod
- Tygerberg Eisteddfod
- Any other local or provincial competition

AND

Performed in a concert at school (solo or small ensemble) in the current year

AND

Achieved 80% or above in subject music in the June examination of the current year

OR

Achieved a Distinction in the ABRSM/Trinity Guildhall Grade 5 Theory of Music examination or equivalent or at least a Merit in the Grade 6 Theory of Music Examination

OPTION 2

Involved in at least three active school music groups for at least three years, including the current year

AND

Selected and performed at national or international level in at least the second round of a competition during the current year (solo or small ensemble) or selected to play in the National Youth Orchestra, the National Youth Wind Orchestra or the National Schools' Big Band

AND

In the past 12 months, has played her solo instrument or in a small ensemble (comprising learners only) in one of the following, and achieved results in the top two categories of awards:

- Cape Town Eisteddfod
- Kaapse Afrikaanse Eisteddfod
- Tygerberg Eisteddfod
- Any other local or provincial competition

AND

Performed in a concert at school (solo or small ensemble) in the current year

AND

Achieved 80% or above in subject music in the June examination of the current year

OR

Achieved a Distinction in the ABRSM/
Trinity Guildhall Grade 5 Theory of Music
examination or equivalent
or at least a Merit in the Grade 6 Theory
of Music Examination

HALF COLOURS

OPTION 1

Involved in at least two active school music groups for at least three years, including the current year

AND

Achieved a minimum of Grade 6 in her solo instrument in the ABRSM/Trinity Guildhall/UNISA/ALMSA/Rockschool examination, and gained at least 75%

AND

In the past 12 months, has played her solo instrument or in a small ensemble (comprising learners only) in one of the following, and achieved results in the top two categories of awards:

- Cape Town Eisteddfod
- Kaapse Afrikaanse Eisteddfod
- Tygerberg Eisteddfod
- Any other local or provincial competition

AND

Performed in a concert at school (solo or small ensemble) in the current year

AND

Achieved 80% or above in subject music in the June examination of the current year

OR

Achieved a Distinction in the ABRSM/ Trinity Guildhall Grade 4 Theory of Music examination or equivalent

OPTION 2

Involved in at least two active school music groups for at least three years, including the current year

AND

Selected and performed in at least the first round of a national competition during the current year (solo or small ensemble) or selected to play in the National Youth Orchestra, the National Youth Wind Orchestra or the National Schools' Big Band

AND

In the past 12 months, has played her solo instrument or in a small ensemble (comprising learners only) in one of the following, and achieved results in the top two categories of awards:

- Cape Town Eisteddfod
- Kaapse Afrikaanse Eisteddfod
- Tygerberg Eisteddfod
- Any other local or provincial competition

AND

Performed in a concert at school (solo or small ensemble) in the current year

AND

Achieved 80% or above in subject music in the June examination of the current year

<u>OR</u>

Achieved a Distinction in the ABRSM/ Trinity Guildhall Grade 4 Theory of Music examination or equivalent

Selected and debated/performed in a senior team at national or international level, in the current year

OR

Selected and debated/performed in a senior team that wins a provincial competition, in the current year

OR

Selected and debated/performed in a senior provincial A team, in the current year

OR

Selected and debated/performed in a senior provincial team for two years, including the current year

HALF COLOURS

Selected and debated/performed in a senior provincial team, in the current year

OR

Selected and debated/performed in a senior Rustenburg school team that has won a national competition (e.g. the National Girls' Schools' Festival Competition), in the current year

OR

Selected and debated/performed in a senior team that has won a regional competition for two years, including the current year

MERIT AWARD

Selected and debated as a member of a team that has won a league/zone, in the current year, **AND** participated in at least 60% of the debates

OR

Won the Best Speaker's award at an average of 50% of the debates over two years, including the current year, **AND** participated in at least 60% of the debates

TEAM AWARD

Represented the school at senior level over a period of two years, including the current year

OR

Represented the school over a period of three years, including the current year

SPORT

In order to be considered for a sport award, the applicant must represent the school within the code, in the current year (i.e. in the year in which the application is made).

It is expected that applicants will have made themselves available for PGSGU and other important tournaments and competitions in the relevant sporting codes.

Meeting the given criteria does not guarantee that the learner will receive the relevant award. The committee reserves the right to award a lesser award in certain circumstances e.g. representing a provincial team in a sport that fewer schools offer/participate in. The Colours Committee will use their discretion in this regard.

Selected and played for a provincial team or a zonal or PSI (Dec) team for three years, one of which was at Under 16 (or equivalent) level or higher, in the current year/season

Selected and played for a provincial team not included in any of the categories above (e.g. U14 A/B, U15 A/B, U16 B/C, U18/19C) in the current year/season

OR

Selected and played for the RGHS Under 19A team / 1st team for two years/seasons, inclusive of the current year/season

Selected and played for a zonal or PSI (Dec) team at Under 14 or Under 16 level in the current year/season

Selected and played for a RGHS team for 3 years/seasons, inclusive of the current year/season

FULL COLOURS

Selected and ran for a national team at Under 16 level or higher in the current year/season **OR**

Selected and ran for a Western Cape team at Under 17/18/19A (or equivalent) level or higher in the current year/season

OR

Selected and ran for a Western Cape team at any level for two years, inclusive of the current year/season

OR

Selected and ran for a provincial team at any level for three years, inclusive of the current year/season

HALF COLOURS

Selected and ran for a national team below Under 16 level in the current year/season

Selected and ran in a Western Cape team at any level in the current year/season

OR

Selected and ran for a provincial team for two years, at any level, inclusive of the current year/season

OR

Selected and ran for a zonal team for three years, at any level, inclusive of the current year/season

OR

Ran for RGHS at 80% of league races, as well as at PGSGU, for three years/seasons, inclusive of the current year/season **AND** selected and ran for a provincial team during her high school career

Ran for RGHS at 80% of league races for 3 years/seasons, inclusive of the current year/season

FULL COLOURS

Selected and swam for a national team at Under 16 level or higher in the current year/season

OR

Qualified and participated at Youth or Senior Nationals in the current year/season **OR**

Qualified and participated at SA National Junior Age Group at age 15 level or higher in the current year/season (must place in the top 8 in at least one race)

OR

Qualified and participated at Regionals/Nationals (any level) for 3 years including the current year/season, one of which was at age 17 or above and one of which was SA National Junior Age Group

HALF COLOURS

Selected and swam for a national team below Under 16 level in the current year/season **OR**

Qualified and participated at SA National Junior Age Group at any age group in the current year/season (no placing required)

OR

Qualified and participated at Level 3 Regional Age Group at age 15 level or higher in the current year/season (must place in the top 8 in at least one race)

OR

Selected and swam for the RGHS swimming team for three years/seasons, inclusive of the current year/season, **AND** participated at Regionals/Nationals (any level) during her high school career

OR

Selected and swam for the RGHS swimming team for four years/seasons, inclusive of the current year/season, **AND** has swum qualifying times Level 3 Regional Age Group or SA National Junior Age Group at an A-League or PGSGU gala in the current year/season

MERIT AWARD

Qualified and participated at Regionals/Nationals (any level) in the current year/season **OR**

Selected and swam for the RGHS 1st team for two year/seasons, inclusive of the current year/season

TEAM AWARD

Selected and swam for a RGHS team for 3 years/seasons, inclusive of the current year/season
